JMcN welcomed members to the meeting then read a statement (circulated to all present) re the bombing in Manchester.

The statement with amendments (from the floor) was *Approved* (unanimously). <start of statement>

University of Liverpool UCU branch condemns the attack at the Manchester Arena where at least 22 people, some of them children, were killed in a suicide bombing during an Ariana Grande concert.

We send our sincere condolences and support to all those injured and to all the families and friends grieving those lost.

Many acts of kindness have been made including from taxi drivers in Manchester and Liverpool, from the medical staff at Alder Hey and many Manchester hospitals, the emergency services and the people of Manchester who opened their doors.

We unequivocally condemn these acts of terror carried out by individuals. This terrorism originated from war. Many 1000s of people have been killed across the world, for example many Syrians lost their lives on the same day as the Manchester attack.

We understand that atrocities have been committed by imperialism and various governments yet the answer is not to kill further innocent individuals, many young, who were simply enjoying a night out.

Manchester was a birth place of trade unions, and our collective strength is one of the main ways to fight all injustice and terror no matter who promotes it.
